



CEMETERY PERMIT BURDEN OF PROOF

Pursuant to Zoning Code Section 22.56.630, the applicant shall substantiate the following:
(Do not repeat the statement or provide Yes/No responses. If necessary, attach additional pages.)

A. That the establishment or maintenance of the proposed cemetery or the extension of an existing cemetery will not jeopardize or adversely affect the public health, safety, comfort or welfare.

B. That such establishment, maintenance or extension will not reasonably be expected to be a public nuisance.

C. That such establishment, maintenance or extension will not interfere with the free movement of traffic or with the proper protection of the public through interference with the movement of police, ambulance or fire equipment, and thus will not interfere with the convenience of the public or the protection of the lives and property of the public.

E. That the applicant, through the proposed perpetual-care fund or otherwise, can demonstrate adequate financial ability to establish and maintain the proposed cemetery so as to prevent the proposed cemetery from becoming a public nuisance.
