Tentative Parcel Map No. 060047 (“PM 060047”) and Conditional Use Permit No. 03-175 (“CUP 03-175”) were considered by Ms. Pat Hachiya, a Hearing Officer of Los Angeles County, on September 4, 2012.

After considering the evidence presented, the Hearing Officer in her action on September 4, 2012, **denied** PM 060047 and CUP 03-175 in accordance with Los Angeles County Code (“County Code”) Section 21.16.060 (Public Hearings), Section 21.40.110 (Matters Required to Complete Submittal and Filing), and Section 22.56.060 (Denial for Lack of Information). A copy of the denial findings is attached.

If no appeal is filed during the specified period, the Hearing Officer’s action is final.

**FINDINGS OF THE HEARING OFFICER
COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES
PROJECT NO. 03-175 - (5)
TENTATIVE PARCEL MAP NO. 060047**

1. The Hearing Officer of Los Angeles County, Ms. Pat Hachiya, considered Tentative Parcel Map ("PM") No. 060047 on September 4, 2012. PM 060047 was considered along with Conditional Use Permit ("CUP") No. 03-175.
2. PM060047 is a request to create four single-family lots on 21 acres within the A-2-1 (Heavy Agricultural - 1 Acre Minimum Required Lot Area) and A-1-1 (Light Agricultural - 1 Acre Minimum Required Lot Area) Zones. The project site is located 3000 feet south of Sierra Highway and 660 feet west of Penman Road in the Soledad Zoned District.
3. CUP 03-175 is a request to ensure compliance with the requirements of nonurban hillside management design criteria.
4. The project was filed with the Los Angeles County Department of Regional Planning ("Regional Planning") on June 16, 2003. The Los Angeles County Subdivision Committee last met on October 27, 2008 to discuss the subject project. Holds were placed on the project. The requested materials were never submitted and no activity has occurred on the project since that time. The last time extension for this project granted by the Director of the Los Angeles County Department of Regional Planning expired on April 15, 2010.
5. Since the applicant failed to provide the requested information and/or materials, there is insufficient information to determine the feasibility of the project design, general plan consistency or whether approval of the map would be in the public interest, pursuant to Section 21.40.160 (Advisory Agency Determination Authority) of the Los Angeles County Code ("County Code"). Because of this, the Subdivision Committee is unable to recommend a final action to the Advisory Agency.
6. Staff sent a letter to the applicant dated July 30, 2012 informing the applicant that pursuant to Section 21.16.060 (Public Hearings) and Section 21.40.110 (Matters Required to Complete Submittal and Filing) of the County Code, the case would be scheduled before a Hearing Officer for denial due to inactivity on September 4, 2012.
7. The July 30, 2012 letter also directed the applicant to contact Regional Planning staff within 30 days for the project to remain active. After contacting Regional Planning staff, the applicant was required to provide a revision to the tentative map and/or submit other requested information within 90 days of the date of the July 30, 2012 letter.

8. The applicant has failed to submit the required materials within the required timeframe (30 days), which was by August 29, 2012.
9. During the September 4, 2012 Hearing Officer public meeting, staff made a brief presentation summarizing the process for denial of a project due to inactivity.
10. During the September 4, 2012 Hearing Officer public meeting, the project applicant was not present. There were no testifiers in support of or in opposition to the project.
11. During the September 4, 2012 Hearing Officer public meeting, the Hearing Officer denied Tentative Parcel Map No. 060047 due to inactivity.

THEREFORE, in view of the findings of fact presented above, Tentative Parcel Map No. 060047 is DENIED.

**FINDINGS OF THE HEARING OFFICER

2. CUP 03-175 is a request to ensure compliance with the requirements of nonurban hillside management design criteria. The project site is located 3000 feet south of Sierra Highway and 660 feet west of Penman Road in the Soledad Zoned District.
3. PM060047 is a request to create four single-family lots on 21 acres within the A-2-1 (Heavy Agricultural - 1 Acre Minimum Required Lot Area) and A-1-1 (Light Agricultural - 1 Acre Minimum Required Lot Area) Zones.
4. The project was filed with the Los Angeles County Department of Regional Planning ("Regional Planning") on June 16, 2003. The Los Angeles County Subdivision Committee last met on October 27, 2008 to discuss the subject project. Holds were placed on the project. The requested materials were never submitted and no activity has occurred on the project since that time. The last time extension for this project granted by the Director of the Los Angeles County Department of Regional Planning expired on April 15, 2010.

7. The July 30, 2012 letter also directed the applicant to contact Regional Planning staff within 30 days for the project to remain active. After contacting Regional Planning staff, the applicant was required to provide a revision to the tentative map and/or submit other requested information within 90 days of the date of the July 30, 2012 letter.
8. The applicant has failed to submit the required materials within the required timeframe (30 days), which was by August 29, 2012.

9. During the September 4, 2012 Hearing Officer public meeting, staff made a brief presentation summarizing the process for denial of a project due to inactivity.
10. During the September 4, 2012 Hearing Officer public meeting, the project applicant was not present. There were no testifiers in support of or in opposition to the project.
11. During the September 4, 2012 Hearing Officer public meeting, the Hearing Officer denied Conditional Use Permit No. 03-175 due to inactivity.

THEREFORE, in view of the findings of fact presented above, Conditional Use Permit No. 03-175 is DENIED.
