**Project Description:** : Proposed amendments to the Los Angeles County Code, Title 22, to correct code references, provisions, and structure; remove duplicative language; reintroduce language from a previous version of Title 22 where needed; clarify permitting for certain land uses; update, streamline or clarify case review procedures for permits; reorganize non-coastal Specific Plans and Fee Programs as new Chapters; make certain uses consistent with recent changes in State law; clarify applicability for certain provisions; and remove an unmapped zone (SR-D).
