NOTICE OF CONTINUED PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION HEARING ON AUGUST 8, 2007 IS CANCELLED. THE REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION WILL CONDUCT A CONTINUED PUBLIC HEARING FOR CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT 03-170- (5) ON WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 14, 2007 AT 9:00 A.M. IN ROOM 150, HALL OF RECORDS, 320 WEST TEMPLE STREET, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA 90012. Interested persons will be given an opportunity to testify. Room 150 will open to the public at 8:50 am.

**PROJECT AND CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT NO. 03-170-(5)**

**CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT REQUEST:** To authorize an increase in allowable daily volume of municipal solid waste intake from 1,700 tons per day to 3,000 tons per day with no expansion of the landfill boundaries in the D-2-1 (Desert Mountain-One Acre Minimum) zone.

**LOCATION OF SUBJECT PROPERTIES:** The subject property is located at 600 East Avenue F, Lancaster, in the Lancaster Zoned District.

These cases do not affect the zoning of surrounding property. If you are unable to attend the public hearing but wish to send written comments, please write to the Planning Commission, 320 West Temple Street, Los Angeles, California 90012. If the final decision on this proposal is challenged in court, testimony may be limited to issues raised at the public hearing or by written correspondence delivered to the Planning Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing.

The County of Los Angeles Department of Regional Planning, acting in the capacity of "Lead Agency" under the County Environmental Guidelines, Chapter III, Section 304, has filed a "Notice of Completion" of a Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for this project. The public review period remains open until the Regional Planning Commission formally closes the public hearing. Written comments on the Draft EIR should be submitted to Christina Tran of the Department of Regional Planning at the above address. All comments received prior to the closing of the public hearing will be considered in the Final EIR.
