NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

The Los Angeles County Hearing Officer will conduct a public hearing on the following project and consider adoption of a Mitigated Negative Declaration. You will have an opportunity to testify or submit written comments.

Project Location: 3371 Rubio Canyon Rd., Altadena

Description: The applicant, Rubio Cañon Land and Water Association, is requesting a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) for the construction and operation of a new water supply well, with accompanying new pump, motor, and piping, in the paved parking lot of an existing water treatment plant and reservoir owned and operated by the Rubio Cañon Land and Water Association in the R-A-2 (Residential Agricultural - 2 Acre Minimum Required Area) zone pursuant to Los Angeles County Code Section 22.20.440. The new well will be 18 inches in diameter, 200 to 300 feet deep, and use a 60 horsepower submersible pump to pump 300 gallons per minute to the existing treatment plant through a new 4-inch diameter, 87-foot long pipeline buried under the parking area with 16 inches of cover.
