

Dear Dept of Regional Planning -

I am opposed to the construction of the 35' fake pine tree to house electric equipment. Aracado Heights is a rare, beautiful, well kept, expensive, agriculture zone community. I want to keep it that way. We already have towers on Won Julian Rd & 6th Ave. They do cause problems with telephones, state K, and after disrupts service. This fake pine tree will do the same - why here of all places?! They are a hazard to honey bees, Bio activity microwave, radiation, wifi, etc, its fatal to bees. They die by the hundreds, they lose their sense of direction. 75% of what we eat depends on honey bee pollination. We have bee keepers in Aracado Heights that will be greatly harmed by this elect tower. If its harmful to bees, what about people & other animals?

The other matter concerning this project is the fact I did not receive a notice

by mail - as many of the neighbors I talked to that will have this in their back yard!

- There was only one sign posted - they couldn't find a worse spot - at the curb entrance to Ralphs Center. If you wanted to read it - you had to park, walk to the side walk, right next to the drive way, risking life & limb & still couldn't read it all. It seems to be a deliberate act to place it so people couldn't read it. I did call & told Ms Bush about it.

Find some where else to erect this tower. We have our share of people trying to come into our area & trying to force zoning change, exceptions, always something we never have any place. NO MORE
