Attached are our responses to comments/questions. Please let us know if you need anything further.

Item: 1 See attached revised maps; "road and trail definitions"

Item: 2 See attached; the new "ground breaking" will be limited to the 12" of width increase and refinement of the social/game trails.

Item: 3 over the last 3 years the annual hiking permits has been on average 16,974. CIC forecasts the visitor use to track the island trends which have been up for the last 3 years and a forecast of approx. 19,000 annual visitors are the best guess at this time. CIC will monitor trails as they do now and close or reroute if needed.

Item: 4 The conservancy's team of Biologists, trail management, Botanist, and wildlife specialists hiked over 50 miles of proposed trails. Through actual physical inspection of the proposed trails they determined that the proposed trails in the attached exhibits were best as they avoided sensitive species, were safest for hikers, provided best connections to public access points and required the least amount of dirt movement and construction activities.

Item: 5 The trail staff will utilize signage as required to minimize public access to areas of concern

Item: 6 We have consulted with LACF and they will minimize the fuel modification to 30 feet radius.

Item: 7 Please see attached revised hiking permit

Item: 8 Please see attached invasive plants monitoring and education addressed.
