At the May 27, 2015 Regional Planning Commission public hearing, staff requested to continue the Animal Facility Ordinance to July 22, 2015 in order to conduct additional community outreach.

Staff has since met with Town Councils and community groups in Agua Dulce, Acton, Antelope Acres, and East Los Angeles to present the ordinance, answer questions, and accept comments. With the feedback received, staff is working with the Department of Animal Care and Control to consider minor revisions to the Animal Facility Ordinance.
