

Meeting Report

May 31, 2008

Community Meeting on The Lakes Community Standards District
Hughes-Elizabeth Lakes Unified School

Summary

The meeting was attended by 52 people, according to the sign-in sheets.

Marshall Adams of the Los Angeles County Department of Regional Planning, Countywide Studies Section, welcomed attendees and opened the meeting at 10:05 a.m.

Information was provided about the Town & Country project, to update the Antelope Valley Area Plan, and notice was given of the upcoming series of meetings across the Valley to produce a vision for the Plan update and the future of the Valley. The first meeting will be at the Lakes Community Center, on June 4th from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. All residents, business owners and other members of the community are encouraged to participate.

Next a presentation was given about the Community Standards District (CSD) proposal, followed by a separate explanation about the Exterior Lighting standards proposal, which is a new document, but intended to be adopted as part of the CSD.

At the conclusion of the presentations and lively discussion of many topics between the audience and Planning staff, an informal poll showed near unanimous support of the proposals as presented.

The next step in the adoption process will be a public hearing by the Regional Planning Commission. This hearing is tentatively scheduled for August 2008, and will be announced and all property owners will be notified by mail again when the date is finalized.
