FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) FLOOD ZONE D – DEFINED AS “AREAS WITH POSSIBLE BUT UNDETERMINED FLOOD HAZARDS. NO FLOOD HAZARD ANALYSIS HAS BEEN CONDUCTED. FLOOD INSURANCE RATES ARE COMMENSURATE WITH THE UNCERTAINTY OF THE FLOOD RISK.”

VERY HIGH FIRE HAZARD SEVERITY ZONE (VHFSHZ) – REFERS TO “AREAS THAT ARE HIGHLY VULNERABLE TO WILDFIRE”, ACCORDING TO TITLE 32 OF THE COUNTY CODE (FIRE CODE; SOURCE - LOS ANGELES COUNTY FIRE DEPARTMENT, 2005). “THE DESIGNATION OF SUCH ZONES SHALL BE MADE BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND SHALL BE BASED ON FUEL LOADING, SLOPE, FIRE WEATHER AND OTHER RELEVANT FACTORS IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 6.8 OF TITLE 5 OF THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNMENT CODE COMMENCING WITH SECTION 51175.”
