 Summary of Changes to Draft Materials Since September 9, 2010

The **Final Draft Community Plan** contains the following changes:

Child Care Infrastructure	Public Services and Facilities	<p>A member of the Land Use Coalition of Public Counsel's Early Care and Education Law Project indicated that the Plan should clarify the availability of certain land use categories for childcare services and reduce barriers to the provision of childcare services. Specifically, requested:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Revising the land use descriptions for the Public/Semi-Public and Commercial categories to explicitly include day care centers 2) Adding a new policy to reduce barriers to proving childcare services 3) Adding a new policy to encourage development of child care centers in or near transit oriented developments 4) Moving the childcare services goal and policies from Public Services and Facilities to the Land Use Section 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Revised the land use category descriptions for Public/Semi-Public and Commercial to explicitly include day care centers 2) Added a new policy under Goal LU-2 to support the development of childcare facilities and services to address shortfalls. 3) Considered and decided against adding a policy under the community circulation goal (M-4) to encourage development of childcare centers near transit oriented developments as no TODs exist nor are proposed. 4) Considered and decided against this move; the addition of day care centers to the land use descriptions in the discussion and legend, along with the new policy in the Land Use element, should address the concern that reference to day care centers were hard to find.
Mitigation Monitoring	N/A	Implementing the Mitigation Measures associated with the Plan's Mitigated Negative Declaration requires adherence with the Mitigation Monitoring Program.	To ensure that mitigations are conveniently accessible, the mitigation monitoring program from the Initial Study / Mitigated Negative Declaration was incorporated in its entirety into the Plan.

The **Final Draft Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration** contains the following changes:

Greenhouse Gases (GHGs)	Greenhouse Gases	AQMD indicated that GHGs were not quantified or compared with significant thresholds.	Revised the discussion to include a quantified analysis of GHG emission that utilized the URBEMIS model to calculate impacts of the Plan and compared them to relevant thresholds.
Air Quality	Air Quality	AQMD indicated that discussion of air quality impacts should be revised.	Revised the air quality discussion to provide more details regarding potential localized air quality impacts from proposed Plan.
