Pursuant to Senate Bill (SB) 35, which added Section 65913.4 to the California Government Code and became effective January 1, 2018, affordable housing projects that are otherwise subject to the approval of a Conditional Use Permit may be reviewed ministerially if such projects meet the requisite eligibility criteria, including but not limited to prevailing wage requirements, which apply to all projects that are/will be funded in whole or in part by public money. Failure to provide accurate and complete information and documentation may delay review or result in denial of the project.

Pursuant to Assembly Bill (AB) 2162, which added Sections 65650 – 65656 to the California Government Code and became effective January 1, 2019, affordable housing projects that are otherwise subject to the approval of a Conditional Use Permit may be reviewed ministerially if such projects meet requisite eligibility criteria, including but not limited to, committed public funding or intent to apply or receive public funding project. Failure to provide accurate and complete information and required documentation may delay review or result in denial of the project.
