**REPORT ON BOARD MOTION REGARDING THE RURAL OUTDOOR LIGHTING
DISTRICT ORDINANCE (AGENDA ITEM NO. 3, OCTOBER 11, 2016)**

On October 11, 2016, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors instructed the Department of Regional Planning to provide a presentation to the La Crescenta Town Council on the Rural Outdoor Lighting District Ordinance.

As directed, Department of Regional Planning staff attended and presented the County's Rural Outdoor Lighting Ordinance to the La Crescenta/Montrose Town Council's Land Use Committee at their regularly scheduled meeting on January 5, 2017. The meeting was attended by approximately 25 community members, in addition to members of the Land Use Committee and the President of the Town Council. Attendees were generally pleased with the presentation on the Rural Outdoor Lighting District and the concepts of "Dark Skies" and are considering the feasibility of incorporating some of its elements into their community plans.
