II. IMPLEMENTATION STATUS UPDATE (PXP)

Drilling began on June 20th and has been monitored by the Environmental Compliance Coordinator. Every person working on site takes CSD training and rig personal receive detailed training. Safety meetings are held twice a day. No complaints have been received related to the drilling operations.

Currently, eight plans are outstanding:

1. Annual Ground Movement Monitoring Survey – pending DPW/DOGGR review
2. Special Status Species and Habitat Protection Plan – PXP estimates resubmittal within 1 month
3. Construction Treatment Plan – PXP estimates resubmittal within 1 month
4. Landscape Plan – PXP estimates resubmittal within 1 month with courtesy distribution to CAP for additional input.
5. Recycling Plan – pending DPW review
6. Water Management Plan – PXP estimates resubmittal within 1 month
7. Equipment Removal Plan – PXP estimates resubmittal within 6 weeks
8. Safety Inspection, Maintenance and Quality Assurance Program – pending LACoFD review.
