- C. AGENCY UPDATES**

**DRP** – Updated the group on general operations at the field and noted no compliance issues with the DRP CSD permit over the last year. Discussed 2013 brush fires at and near the oil field and the request by the CAP at the January 2014 meeting for additional information on the fire incidents.

**DPW** – Provided overview of the review of the 2013 Ground Movement Survey Report. DPW will provide an overview presentation at a forthcoming CAP meeting on the Ground Movement Survey Report.

**DPH** – Reported that noise monitoring continues and that the oil field is in compliance with DPH noise regulations.

**LACoFD** – Noted that the hazardous material/business plan documentation is now electronic (CERS) and FM O&G is in compliance. The oil field is up to date with the LACoFD weed abatement requirement.

**CCFD** – Provided information on the brush fires occurring in Culver City jurisdiction, 2 caused by Edison equipment and 2 by oil field electrical equipment. Noted that Culver City requires permits for the electrical work in the oil field.

**DOGGR** – Provided a summary of the 2013 drilling activities and noted no compliance issues. Provided that DOGGR records list 4 fires and 2 spills at the oil field in 2013. Noted recent investigation of a property damage complaint in the Windsor Hills area. Updated group on the ground movement research and that additional information is needed for the analysis, a data request to FM O&G is forthcoming.

**RWQCB** – Absent.
