A return call was made at 10:05 a.m. to the resident with the results of the investigation with the recommendation to please call the 1-800 number when you smell an odor so FM O&G can investigate immediately. Although this was not related to an airborne odor complaint, we investigated field operations and no issues were identified. There were also no alarms from the air monitoring equipment at the gas plant and the drilling rig is currently in the process of moving well locations.
