

Baldwin Hills CSD and EIR Community Interview Sessions Summary

The following is a list of issues discussed during community interview sessions held in May, 2007.

- **Health** – long term health effects; should conduct cancer cluster studies; high incidence of asthma
- **Trust** – the community does not trust the oil operator; there should be better communication
- **Noise** – hissing noise; metal on metal clanking; late night deliveries; truck back-up alarm in the middle of the night
- **Air quality (odors)** – lack of comprehensive air contamination study/monitoring; long term health affects associated with odorless air emissions
- **Vibration** – ground rumbling; property damage; no particular pattern to vibration incidents; incidents tend to last from 1 to 4 hours
- **Geology** - How does drilling affect premature slippage along the Inglewood Fault Line?
- **Water injection** – How does water injection affect soil/ground stability?
- **Experimental technology** – uncertain impacts
- **Fire hazard** – fire abatement plan should be required
- **Proper emergency response** – oil operator should maintain proper coverage in case of emergency; the County should have an emergency response plan
- **Aesthetics** – unsightly grading; lack of screening/landscaping; old rusty equipment; negative effect on property values
- **Light pollution** – bright lights during 24-hour drilling activity
