DESCRIPTION OF THE SUBMITTAL

Los Angeles County has proposed a Local Coastal Program (LCP) for the Santa Monica Mountains segment of the County's coastal zone. The proposed Santa Monica Mountains LCP consists of two parts: 1) a Land Use Plan, and 2) a Local Implementation Plan. The County is requesting an amendment to its existing certified Land Use Plan, consisting of a comprehensive update to replace the existing Land Use Plan with a new proposed Land Use Plan. The County is also requesting certification of a new Local Implementation Plan. At the public hearing, the Coastal Commission will consider the: (1) certification of the Land Use Plan portion of the proposed LCP, and (2) extension of time for Commission action on the Implementation Plan portion of the proposed LCP, in order to allow adequate time for Commission staff review of the proposed Implementation Plan.

HEARING PROCEDURES:

This item has been scheduled for a public hearing and vote. People wishing to testify on this matter may appear at the hearing and/or may present their concerns in writing to the Commission before the hearing date.

ALLOTTED TIME FOR TESTIMONY:

Oral testimony may be limited to 2 minutes for each speaker depending on the number of persons wishing to be heard.

WRITTEN MATERIALS:

Written materials must be submitted to the Commission staff no later than three working days before the hearing (staff will then distribute your materials to the Commission).
