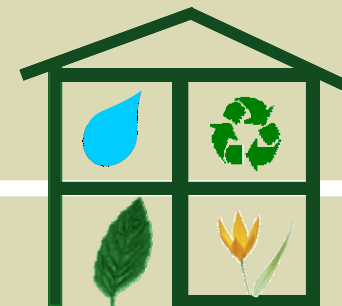

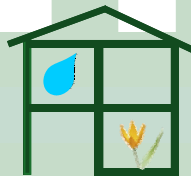
## Green Building Program
