



POMONA FREEWAY (SR-60) HOV (CARPOOL LANE) CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Project Description:

- **Location and Limits:**

Both directions on the Pomona Freeway (SR-60) between the San Gabriel River Freeway (I-605) in the City of Industry and Orange Freeway (SR-57) in Diamond Bar.

- **Background:**

The Pomona Freeway (SR-60) is a major urban freeway which has a dual function. First, it serves as a corridor that links the Los Angeles and communities located in the San Gabriel Valley, Riverside, and San Bernardino Counties. Second, it serves as a truck route to provide freeway access for oversized trucks.

- **What The Work Involves:**

This project will improve traffic flow on the Pomona Freeway between the San Gabriel River Freeway (I-605) and Brea Canyon Road with the addition of one High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane in each direction. Additionally, soundwalls will be constructed at various locations.

- **Benefits:**

This freeway improvement will extend the existing HOV lanes on the freeway and assist carpool commuters in their daily travel, improve safety, and accommodate oversized trucks. When complete, the Pomona Freeway will have continuous HOV Lanes between the San Gabriel River Freeway and Riverside County.

Schedules:

Construction Begins: Spring 2007

Construction Ends: Summer 2011

Total Programmed Project Costs: \$ 125 Million
