Re Significant Ecological Area Ordinance

**The restriction on private property boundary fencing will endanger our community!** If we are not allowed to fence our property, along the roadways, then any person can enter our property. At night, strangers can party and smoke on our property. We have already gone through the experience of finding a poor young woman's body dumped in our community. Most of Lobo Canyon Rd. has a three rail fence running along the north side of the street. A good portion of the fence is set back from the asphalt to allow people and horses to walk along the side of the road off the asphalt. Three rail fences have no effect on wildlife movements. In addition, the rule of thumb that good fences make good neighbors should not be ignored. Regional Planning should reconsider this dangerous restriction especially in our rural neighborhoods.
