We received your letter dated August 31, 2020 with comments on the draft of the abovereferenced project. This letter is in response to the two comments raised in your letter.

1. Driveways.

This is in response to Phoenix Khoury's comment. After discussion with the project working group, the group reached consensus that it was best to remove the proposed language on driveway widths from the ordinance for this 2020-2021 cycle. Language was originally inserted to codify Fire Department's requirements, but it turns out there could be unintended consequences for development potential of flag lots and compact lot subdivisions. Further discussions with Public Works and the Fire Department would need to occur prior to addressing this issue in a future cycle.

Conversion of LOS to VMT for traffic studies.

This issue was raised by Kent Tsuji. However, this comment is specific to the Marina Del Rev Specific Plan (Sections 22.46.1180 and 22.46.1190). Any changes to code text that requires review and certification by the California Coastal Commission, including LIP and Specific Plans, are outside the scope of this Ordinance project. Rob Glaser of the Coastal Section has indicated that a separate update is planned for the Coastal Specific Plans in the near future, and this issue will be addressed as part of that update. The Section is already implementing the SB 743 guidelines for review of Coastal projects.
