- 4(a). Project No. 2019-002681-(3) (Mr. Chen) Emergency Coastal Development Permit No. RPPL2020001299 Applicant: Los Angeles County Department of Public Works Mulholland Highway at Mile Marker (MM) 2.52 The Malibu Zoned District

To authorize the removal of five (5) oak trees associated with emergency repair work and restoration of roads and highways damaged by erosion during rains following the 2018 Woolsey Fire. Pursuant to County Code Section 22.44.960(F)(2) the applicant shall submit a complete application for a Coastal Development Permit (CDP) or comparable entitlement within ninety (90) days of issuance of the emergency permit.

4(b). Project No. 2020-000407-(1-5) Senate Bill 743 Update (Mr. Tsuji)

Senate Bill 743 requires local agencies to adopt a metric and threshold of significance to be used for transportation analysis under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and be implemented by July 1, 2020. This new metric must be based on Vehicle Miles Traveled (VMT) and will replace the current Level of Service (LOS) methodology.

To implement this new change, the Los Angeles County (County) Department of

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Public Works, in collaboration with the County Chief Executive Office, Department of Regional Planning, Department of Parks and Recreation and Department of Public Health, is developing VMT metrics and a threshold of significance for consideration by the Board of Supervisors. These recommendations will also include project screening criteria and potential traffic mitigation measures to support the shift from LOS to VMT.

GLOSSARY OF ENVIRONMENTAL TERMS:

CEQA – California Environmental Quality Act EIR – Environmental Impact Report MND – Mitigated Negative Declaration ND – Negative Declaration CE – Categorical Exemption

TIME LIMITS: The Commission has established time limits with respect to receipt of testimony regarding matters on this Agenda. Applicants will be allowed fifteen (15) minutes to present testimony in support of their application, with an additional ten (10) minutes for responses to issues raised by other witnesses. Other proponents and opponents will be limited to three (3) minutes per speaker. Responses to questions from the Commission will not be included in these time limitations. All speakers are urged to refrain from repeating testimony presented by others. The Chair may impose different time limits, depending upon the length of the agenda, the number of speakers wishing to give testimony and/or the complexity of an agenda item.

TIME LIMITS FOR APPEAL ITEMS: Appellant and applicant shall be provided equal time to present evidence. The Commission shall determine the time limit based on the complexity of the case and the length of the agenda. Time will also be allocated to the appellant for rebuttal.

WRITTEN TESTIMONY: Written testimony that is received prior to the public hearing will be made a part of the record and need not be read into the record.

PUBLIC HEARING CLOSING AND RE-OPENING: Public hearings that are closed during the course of the meeting may be re-opened by the Commission without notice at any time prior to adjournment of the meeting.

LOBBYIST REGISTRATION: Any person who seeks support or endorsement from the Regional Planning Commission on any official action may be subject to the provisions of Ordinance No. 93-0031, relating to lobbyists.
