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
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Project Area Overview





Metro Area Plan (MAP Project) Goals

Consolidate and Update Existing Regulations

- Simplify and consolidate in one place various overlapping plans that apply to each of the communities.
- Eliminate duplication and potential regulatory conflicts

Prioritize Equity and Environmental Justice

- Recognize that MAP communities have historically been disadvantaged via past policies and decisions.

More and Better access to open space

- Study need for new parks and recreational amenities
- Make it safer to walk and bike to open space areas

Study all Aspects of Future Housing

- Need for affordable housing
- Suitability of new housing in proximity to transit stops
- Potential residential displacement

Facilitate Employment Opportunities


- Neighborhood-serving commercial in residential areas
- Allow for clean industrial, small-scale manufacturing, and life science facilities



CEQA Requirements



California Environmental Quality Act



- 1. Inform decision-makers and public about potentially significant physical effects on the environment.
- 2. Identify ways to avoid or significantly reduce environmental impacts.
- 3. Prevent significant avoidable impacts through feasible alternatives and/or mitigation.
- 4. If a project is approved with significant impacts, disclose to the public the reasons why.



Purpose of a Scoping Meeting

To help determine the scope and content of the environmental information to be analyzed in the PEIR through consultation with:

- Responsible and trustee agencies
- Adjacent cities/counties
- Public transit agencies
- Interested organizations or individuals

This is an information-gathering meeting



CEQA Process and Schedule



Contents of the Program EIR

- 1. Environmental setting (baseline for impact analysis)
- 2. Project description and objectives
- 3. Direct, indirect and cumulative impacts analyses
- 4. Ways to avoid or reduce significant environmental impacts (mitigation measures & alternatives)
- 5. Effects not found significant
- 6. Organizations and persons consulted

Update Land Use Policy/Zoning Maps



MAP Project Overview

Update Land Use/Zoning Policy Maps

- Implement changes from Housing Element Update
- Redesignate A-1 Zones to R-1 Zones to reflect existing uses
- Redesignate certain industrial areas "Industrial Research" land use and "Manufacturing Research and Development" (MRD) zone.
 - Within East Los Angeles, Willowbrook, West Rancho Dominguez-Victoria, and Florence-Firestone



General Plan Amendments

Establish the Metro Area Plan (MAP)

Revise Chapter 3: Add Guiding Principle #6

 Promote Strengths, Community Voice, and Equity Outcomes

Rescind 3 adopted community/neighborhood plans

 East Los Angeles Community Plan, Walnut Park Neighborhood Plan, and West Athens-Westmont Community Plan



General Plan Amendment

Revise Chapter 6: Land Use Element

- New Industrial Research land use for clean industrial and life science facilities
- New Accessory Commercial Unit (ACU) policy for neighborhood scale retail on corner lots in residential areas











Zone Changes

Update Zoning Map

- Maintain consistency with General Plan Land Use Map changes described above
- Update zoning map for East LA 3rd Street, Connect Southwest LA, and Willowbrook TOD Specific Plans
- Implement rezoning from Housing Element Update
- Rezone Agricultural (A-1) parcels to Residential (R-1)



Amend Title 22, Planning and Zoning

Revise 6 Community Standards Districts

Establish Areawide Standards District

Codify TOD Specific Plans with Title 22 numbering

Create new development standards for low to mid-density housing

Update design standards for:

- Industrial developments
- Open space
- Small neighborhood scale retail






RESIDENTIAL REZONE - EAST LOS ANGELES








