### Meeting Notes:

# Chief Sustainability Office

- Chief Sustainability Office has a plan to use youth engagement for Chief Sustainability Plan
  - This will be done in schools through "anchor" organizations in each Supervisorial District (example: "Day One")
- There will be one summit in each Supervisorial District.
- Sustainability Plan finalization: 2019
  - Updated Climate Action Plan should be done prior to 2020, and will include regulatory policies.

- Cal-Adapt has interactive climate data that we can incorporate into the community profiles.
- Hilton Foundation wants to spend funds on wildlife resiliency.
  - o Could potentially lead to new wildfire-related planning efforts

### Metrolink

- 25% discount has been very successful; program will break even in just a few years
- Several projects in the works after receiving a grant
- Metrolink is looking to get bidirectional service all day on the San Bernardino line with 30 minute headways. They are also trying to get express service and smaller trainsets for more flexibility.
- San Gabriel Valley COG is also allocating money for first/last mile improvements in the area

## **Department of Public Works**

- Food Drop program
  - o Effort to get institutions and business to donate unused food to food banks and shelters
- Environmental Programs
  - o Household waste and illegal dumping campaigns and outreach is in progress.
  - Smart gardening workshops
    - Could be a way to collaborate on public engagement.

#### **WDACS**

- Plans to update the group with information from organizations in their network, including job centers and other service-related agencies.
- Possible collaboration opportunity between WDACS and Metrolink regarding a Senior Transit Ambassador program.
