The Project also includes a zone change program to add the Green Zone (-GZ) Combining Zone on industrially-zoned parcels that are subject to the existing Green Zones regulations in the unincorporated communities of West Carson and West Whittier – Los Nietos.

KEY ISSUES:The Project amends Title 22 (Planning and Zoning)
of the County Code to simplify language, correct
errors and omissions, and remove redundant
regulations and internal inconsistencies in the Green
Zones Ordinance.

The Project amends the Zoning Map to add the -GZ Combining Zone on industrially-zoned parcels that are subject to existing Green Zones regulations in the unincorporated communities of West Carson and West Whittier – Los Nietos.

- **MAJOR POINTS FOR:** The Project supports the implementation of the Green Zones Ordinance, which addresses environmental justice in unincorporated Los Angeles County.
- **MAJOR POINTS AGAINST:** The project amends a recently established ordinance, which may cause confusion among property owners, operators, and community members.
