Chiquita Canyon Landfill - Supplemental CUP Condition No. 69 Report

Dear Mr. Nguyen:

Re:

Condition 69 of Chiquita Canyon, LLC's ("Chiquita") Conditional Use Permit ("CUP") requires that, upon receiving four Notices of Violation ("NOVs") related to air quality in a given calendar year, Chiquita must submit a report to Los Angeles County Public Works ("PW") within 30 days after the fourth NOV, explaining the NOV and the steps taken to address it. Chiquita must also provide such a report within 30 days of receiving any additional air quality related NOVs within the same calendar year. The South Coast Air Quality Management District ("South Coast AQMD") issued Chiquita NOVs for violations of South Coast AQMD Rule 402 and California Health & Safety Code § 41700 that were alleged to have occurred on May 17, May 18, June 25, and June 27, triggering Chiquita's obligation to provide a report under Condition 69. These NOVs were addressed in a report dated July 27, 2023. The July 27 report also covered subsequent Rule 402 NOVs issued by the South Coast AQMD in June and July 2023 and one public health notice issued by the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health.

Since the submission of the July 27, 2023 report, the South Coast AQMD issued Chiquita twenty-five additional NOVs for violations alleged to have occurred in July and August, 2023. Chiquita also received an identical NOV for violations alleged to have occurred on July 24, 2023 and inadvertently left this NOV out of the July 27 report. On August 18, 2023, the Los Angeles County Department of Regional Planning ("DRP") issued Chiquita an NOV for violations of CUP Conditions 12 and 63. Chiquita is submitting this report in compliance with its obligations under Condition 69 in regards to the NOVs received on July 24, 2023 and since the submission of the July 27 report.

South Coast AQMD NOVs – Explanation and Corrective Action

A discussion of each NOV, along with corrective action taken by Chiquita in response to these NOVs, is provided below.

Explanation

Each of the NOVs issued by South Coast AQMD made identical allegations. The NOVs are provided at Attachment A.¹ Each NOV was issued after a South Coast AQMD inspector verified complaints about odors alleged to be coming from the Chiquita Canyon Landfill ("Landfill"). The source of the complaints was not disclosed in any of the NOVs.

The NOV issued by DRP alleged that Chiquita is in violation of Conditions 12 and 63 of Chiquita's CUP because of the NOVs issued by the South Coast AQMD between May 17 and August 16, 2023. The DRP NOV is provided at Attachment B.

The odor complaints underlying both the South Coast AQMD NOVs and the DRP NOV were made to the South Coast AQMD, not Chiquita. As PW knows, odor science and forensics are complex, and an odor complaint outside of the Landfill can have numerous potential sources, both inside and outside of the Landfill. Any time Chiquita is notified of an alleged odor complaint, Chiquita quickly evaluates the four primary potential sources of odor from a landfill – exposed waste at the working face, landfill gas ("LFG"), leachate, and LFG condensate – and takes appropriate action to further reduce any potential that one of these areas is generating offsite odors. The actions taken by Chiquita to address these four primary potential sources of odor at the Landfill are described in the discussion of corrective actions below.

Chiquita believes that the most likely source of any odors coming from the Landfill is an increase in the production of LFG at the Landfill. Chiquita believes this increase in LFG production is due to an abnormal biotic or abiotic process (a reaction) taking place within a portion of the Landfill waste mass. This reaction is **not** the result of a fire or other combustion within the waste mass, and, in fact, results in the increased generation of process water.

This reaction is producing higher than normal levels of dimethyl sulfide ("DMS"). DMS is produced when plant matter decomposes (or breaks down). DMS is also produced by marine planktonic microorganisms and is one of the main odors of sea air. The toxicity information on DMS available suggests that it does not have the potential health impacts of hydrogen sulfide

("H₂S"). Note that this is not dimethyl sulfate, a different chemical, although the names are similar.

Chiquita and the onsite landfill-gas-to-energy plant operated by a separate entity, Ameresco Chiquita Energy LLC ("Ameresco"), are both operating LFG processing systems under variances from the South Coast AQMD, the conditions of which facilitate the entities' abilities to address the underlying reaction in an effort to shorten the reaction time. Chiquita's variance allows Chiquita to continue processing LFG produced by the unexpected reaction. The variance requires Chiquita, under the oversight of South Coast AQMD, to expedite the replacement of carbon media used to treat LFG in its LFG treatment system; prioritize and maximize the use and operation of its newer, more efficient LFG flare; regularly sample and analyze the LFG and surface emissions and report the results to the South Coast AQMD on a monthly basis; and continue to investigate potential systems for treating the LFG. Under this variance, Chiquita is monitoring the DMS levels in the LFG on a daily basis and submitting monthly reports to the South Coast AQMD with the results.

The unexpected increase in LFG production is further exacerbating Chiquita's limited flaring capacity. As with all landfills, LFG production tends to increase over time as the waste mass increases and older wastes continue to decay. Chiquita routinely models the increase in LFG production to determine whether its flaring capacity is sufficient. In 2020, Chiquita determined that it would need more flare capacity by late 2022 to handle the projected increased quantity of LFG. The unanticipated reaction is producing LFG beyond the previously modeled LFG production curve, thus increasing the need for additional flaring capacity. Chiquita and Ameresco together do not have sufficient capacity to pull and process the requisite amount of LFG from the system to decrease the reaction. When Ameresco is non-operational, Chiquita's processing capacity is at a greater deficit. The inability to adequately pull and process LFG from the system may also contribute to LFG-related odors.

Corrective Action

Chiquita provided a detailed description of corrective actions taken to mitigate the reaction and any odors emanating from the Landfill in the July 27, 2023 Condition 69 report. Chiquita continues to take all actions listed in the July 27 report. This report describes only updates or new actions taken since the July 27 report. All of Chiquita's odor mitigation efforts take into account the wind patterns identified as the Unfavorable Wind Conditions as part of Chiquita's prior Stipulated Order for Abatement with South Coast AQMD in Case No. 6177-1.

<u>Increasing flare capacity</u>: As noted in the July 27 report, increasing flare capacity is crucial to addressing the underlying reaction and addressing any potential LFG-related odors. Chiquita had taken steps to prepare for the natural increase in LFG production, which would assist with the increase in LFG production caused by the reaction, but that preparation has taken longer than anticipated. In September 2020, Chiquita submitted a permit application to South Coast AQMD for a new flare that would allow the Landfill to better control this increasing quantity of LFG. Chiquita planned to install the new flare in early 2022. However, Chiquita is still awaiting

approval of the permit for this new flare. On August 1, 2023, the South Coast AQMD completed its evaluation of the permit application and sent it to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") for its review and approval. Chiquita mailed public notice of this permit application to residents within a quarter mile of the Landfill on August 8, 2023, as required by South Coast AQMD Rule 212(d). The public notice provides for a 30-day public comment period. EPA has 45 days to review and respond to the permit application, however, this review period may be delayed if the South Coast AQMD receives public comments on the application that require substantive responses.

Chiquita received the requisite building permit for construction of this flare from the County on August 14, 2023.

Once the new flare is fully permitted and operational, Chiquita will be able to pull and process more LFG, which will help slow down the reaction and decrease LFG-related odors. South Coast AQMD has informed Chiquita that Chiquita may expect to receive the permit in early September. If Chiquita receives the permit in early September, it expects to finish installing and start operating the new flare by the end of September. Based on this schedule, Chiquita expects the new flare's impacts to be felt by mid-October.

Chiquita is also in the process of applying for a second new flare, understanding that it will take potentially several more years for the permit to be reviewed and approved.

Portable Thermal Oxidizer: As discussed in the July 27 report, Chiquita has deployed a portable thermal oxidizer ("TOX") for additional control capacity in the short-term. The TOX has been in operation since mid-July, and Chiquita is taking measures to maximize its capacity by reducing the amount of liquids or condensate that enters the TOX system. Chiquita's goal is to allow the TOX to process approximately 1,500 to 1,800 standard cubic feet per minute ("scfm") of LFG. Chiquita achieved this goal in late July, but the TOX has more recently been operating at a lower capacity. Chiquita is working with the TOX vendor to identify and correct the issues and to get the TOX back to its optimal processing capacity.

Chiquita is also investigating further options for obtaining an additional TOX or other type of rental flare that the Landfill may be able to use in the short-term to further increase control capacity. If Chiquita is able to locate another TOX or rental flare, it will provide an update on the timing for when it can be brought on site.

Expanding the LFG Well System: As discussed in the July 27 report, Chiquita first expanded the LFG well system by installing five deep trench collectors and installing additional leachate extraction pumps along the west slope. Since the July 27 report, Chiquita has installed an additional two leachate extraction pumps, for a total of six new pumps. At the time of the July 27 report, Chiquita had begun to install eighteen vertical dual extraction wells designed to collect both LFG and leachate. This first phase of expansion and installation of vertical dual extraction wells is now complete. Chiquita is in the process of connecting the new vertical wells to the gas system, which it expects to be complete in August.

Chiquita has also designed a second phase of the expansion project with more than eighteen additional dual extraction wells. Chiquita expects to begin drilling these Phase 2 wells the week of August 21 and to complete the installation of these wells by mid-October.

Increasing liquids extraction and removal capabilities: The reaction results in the production of excess liquids. Removing these liquids both removes heat from the reaction to help slow it down and limits the impact of liquids on LFG collection. Chiquita is enhancing the liquids extraction, pumping, storage, and disposal system at the Landfill to improve liquids management. This includes outfitting LFG wells with liquids pumps and installing dedicated liquids removal wells in areas affected by liquids, increasing pumping and piping capabilities for liquids transport, increasing on-site storage capacity for liquids, and securing other options for liquids disposal in case current options become limiting.

More specifically, Chiquita is upgrading the pumps in wells CV-2201, CV-2203 and CV-2204 to electrical pumps that will allow for more consistent liquid extraction. The electrical pump in well CV-2201 has been in operation since late July. The electrical pumps in wells CV-2203 and CV-2204 were installed in late July, but Chiquita needs to change some parts for proper operation. Chiquita has scheduled the installation of the replacement parts for the week of August 21.

Chiquita is also evaluating the Phase 1 and Phase 2 vertical wells discussed above for pump installations. Chiquita will review down well temperatures and liquid depths to determine the appropriate pump option. Depending on the availability of the materials, Chiquita expects to complete the pump installations for the Phase 1 vertical wells by mid-October and for the Phase 2 vertical wells by the end of the year.

Finally, Chiquita has ordered three additional liquids storage tanks, which are scheduled to be delivered the week of August 21. The additional tanks will increase the Landfill's liquids storage capacity by approximately 50,000 gallons.

Installing geosynthetic cover over the reaction area: Chiquita is in the process of designing and will install geosynthetic cover over the reaction area of the Landfill to limit the migration of LFG from the site. The geosynthetic cover will cover approximately thirty acres of the Landfill. Chiquita anticipates completing the design for the geosynthetic cover by August 25. Chiquita will then obtain and install the material. Chiquita expects the cover to be installed by the end of October.

<u>Distributing air filtration devices to local residents</u>: On August 9, 2023, Chiquita launched a Local Resident Air Filter Program. Chiquita purchased a number of in-home air filtration devices and is currently distributing them upon request to those community members closest to the Landfill and affected by odors. To receive an air filtration device, community members complete a simple form which is available on Chiquita's website and which Chiquita has distributed to the community via email and flyers directly to residents. Community members pick up the devices at a designated pick-up location during certain morning and afternoon hours. The designated pick-

up location and times are posted on Chiquita's webpage. Chiquita is also responding to those who complete the forms with pick up location and time information. Chiquita will also deliver devices to the homes of seniors or those not physically able to pick up a device. As of the date of this letter, over 455 filters have been picked up by local residents or delivered to homes and another 418 filters have been requested.

Enhanced and expanded community air monitoring: At the direction of the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health ("DPH"), Chiquita is enhancing and expanding its current air monitoring program to include monitoring for DMS and other constituents in the community, sampling at residential locations where recent odor complaints have been reported, sampling at additional on-site locations, and conducting a flux chamber study. Chiquita will report all monitoring results to DPH. For additional information on this expanded air monitoring, please see Chiquita's August 15 submission to DPH.

Develop a root cause analysis and investigate potential landfill gas treatment options: As directed by the South Coast AQMD, Chiquita submitted a root cause analysis to the South Coast AQMD on February 22, 2023. In accordance with its variance, Chiquita will continue to update the root cause analysis, as needed and submit those updates, if any, to the South Coast AQMD in its monthly reports. Under the variance, Chiquita is also investigating potential LFG treatment options specifically targeted toward removing DMS from the LFG. For additional information on the root cause analysis and the potential LFG treatment option investigation, please see Chiquita's August 18 submission to PW.



What is a Notice of Violation?

A Notice of Violation is issued by an SCAQMD Air Quality Inspector to inform a business that a failure to comply with one or more applicable federal, state, and/or local (SCAQMD) air pollution rules and regulations or legal requirements is being alleged.

What happens when I receive a Notice of Violation?

If you are operating in violation of one or more applicable federal, state, and/or local (SCAQMD) air pollution rules and regulations or legal requirements, each day or part of a day that you operate in violation is considered a separate violation even if only one Notice of Violation has been issued. Continuing to operate in violation may subject you to substantial civil or criminal penalties. It is in your best interest to resolve any compliance problem immediately before you resume operation.

What if I need to continue to operate the equipment named in the Notice of Violation?

If continued operation of equipment cited in the Notice of Violation is necessary, you may be able to obtain a variance from SCAQMD's Hearing Board. A *variance* is an administrative order that allows a company to continue operating without penalties while it takes appropriate steps to meet air pollution control requirements. Proof of specific legal circumstances must be provided before a variance can be granted. Timeliness in seeking such relief will be considered by the Hearing Board. Additional information concerning variances can be found in California Health & Safety Code §§ 42350-42359.5 and at http://www.aqmd.gov/home/about/hearing-board.

During a hearing for a variance, you may be represented either by yourself or by your attorney or consultant. You will have the opportunity to present evidence and testimony, and to cross-examine any SCAQMD witness.

If you fail to comply with any order of the Hearing Board, you may be subject to additional civil or criminal penalties set forth in California Health & Safety Code §§ 42400 et seq. and 42402 et seq.

How are Notices of Violation resolved?

The SCAQMD General Counsel's office reviews each alleged violation and, based on the facts, determines how best to resolve the allegation. Options available to the General Counsel's office include:

Minor Source Penalty Assessment Program

Certain Notices of Violation may be eligible for resolution through SCAQMD's Minor Source Penalty Assessment Program if they are issued to a minor source or for violations other than emitting air toxics or creating a

public nuisance involving injury or property damage.

If your case is handled by this program, you will receive a letter or phone call from an investigator in the SCAQMD General Counsel's office offering to settle your violation. Settlement terms usually call for a penalty payment and written proof of current compliance. The investigator's name and telephone number are included in the initial settlement letter in the event you would like to discuss the case.

Be prepared to describe any facts about the violation that you believe SCAQMD should know in considering your case. Sharing your knowledge of the facts, possible causes for the violation and plans to avoid future violations will help the investigator arrive at an appropriate disposition.

Be sure to respond by the date indicated in the letter to avoid further legal action.

If the Minor Source Penalty Assessment Program fails to result in a settlement, your Notice of Violation may be referred to an SCAQMD attorney and handled under the procedures for Civil Prosecution or resolved through a Small Claims Court.

Civil Prosecution

If your case is handled as a civil matter, it will be reviewed by an attorney from the SCAQMD General Counsel's office, who will typically make first contact with you through a letter that asks for information about your case. If the allegations in the Notice of Violation cannot be informally resolved, the SCAQMD is authorized to file a civil lawsuit in court to recover civil penalties. In cases involving serious harm or danger, however, SCAQMD may immediately commence a legal action for civil penalties and a court-ordered injunction. A mandatory injunction is a court order compelling a person and/or company to take specific action. A prohibitory injunction is a court order compelling a person and/or company to refrain from taking a specific action. Injunctions, which may even lead to shutting down a business, may be sought by SCAQMD to prevent continuing or serious violations or damages from occurring.

• Criminal Prosecution

If SCAQMD determines that criminal prosecution is appropriate, the case will be referred to the appropriate state or federal law enforcement agency. That agency will determine if criminal prosecution is warranted.

Civil and Criminal Penalties

Penalties are determined by California Health & Safety Code §§ 42400 et seq. and 42402 et seq.



A review of Conditional Use Permit (CUP) 200400042 and the inspection results for the Chiquita Canyon Landfill (Landfill) operations located at 29201 Henry Mayo Drive, Castaic, CA, disclosed the following violation(s):

Conditional Use Permit Violations

One or more conditions of an approved CUP are not being met (Los Angeles County Zoning Code: 22.02.030(B); 22.242.020; 22.242.030)

Condition 12. The subject property shall be developed, maintained, and operated in full compliance with the conditions of this grant, and any law, statute, ordinance, or other regulation applicable to any development or activity on the subject property. Failure of the permittee to cease any development or activity not in full compliance shall be a violation of this grant.

Chiquita Canyon, LLC (CCL) is in violation of Condition 12 of the CUP as it has received 44 Notices of Violation (NOV) between May 17, 2023 and August 16, 2023 for violating Southern California Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) Rule 402 and California Health & Safety Code Section 41700 in relation to nuisance odors that are emanating from the Landfill.
