



PROJECT GOALS

Establish Policies for Sustainable Development

 Guide development in creating a balance between housing and jobs, as well as creation of green and natural spaces

Prioritize Equity and Environmental Justice

 Utilize an environmental justice and equity lens to evaluate all recommendations.

Consider Different Ways to Move Around Communities

- Encourage transit and active transportation (walking and biking) as ways of traveling within the South Bay.



Implement the Countywide Housing Element

 Increase potential for diverse housing types in the South Bay, including affordable housing.

Celebrate Community Identity and Culture

- Seek our special places or traditions that are meaningful to the community and recommend ways to preserve and celebrate them.

Ensure Consistency Between Land Use and Zoning

- In accordance with state law, make technical corrections to ensure consistency between land use and zoning

LAND USE + ZONING MAPS

- A review of all properties in the South Bay Planning Area was completed with changes proposed in the following categories:
 - Technical Cleanup
 - Transitioning Uses
 - Housing Element
 - Housing Opportunities





TECHNICAL CLEANUP

- California Government Code 65860
- Review of zoning and land use consistency
- Proposed updates to zoning or land use to correct inconsistencies



Policy LU 2.10: Ensure consistency between land use policy and zoning by undergoing a comprehensive zoning consistency analysis that includes zoning map changes and Zoning Code amendments, as needed.



TRANSITIONING USES

- Redesignate parcels to reflect changing development patterns
- Light Industrial (IL) to Commercial (CG) or Residential (R-3)



Policy LU 4.2: Encourage the adaptive reuse of underutilized structures and the revitalization of older, economically distressed neighborhoods.






HOUSING ELEMENT

- Housing policy guide for the County's unincorporated areas
- Identified housing conditions and needs, and establishes the County's housing strategy through goals and policies
- Updated every eight years









HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES

- Proximity to high quality transit
- Areas that can accommodate additional density
- Future planning




Policy LU 4.3: Encourage transit-oriented development in urban and suburban areas with the appropriate residential density along transit corridors and within station areas.



TITLE 22 UPDATES

- Reorganize and streamline the West Carson Transit Oriented District (TOD) Specific Plan
- Revise existing and create new development and/or design standards:
 - Facilitate well-designed multifamily residential and mixed-use developments
 - Allow for small neighborhood scale retail and commercial





 - 178 Responses






PROJECT POSTCARD








COMMUNITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

- Participate in up to eight CAC meetings. Typically, these will be scheduled in advance of public workshops and serve as a forum to vet and review draft materials.
