

HCS Definition

An HCS:

- Is a document that identifies the important themes relevant to the history and development of the built environment of a geographic area.
- Establishes periods of historical significance for each of the important themes, while identifying significant property types.
- Is the background information for a historic resource survey.



HCS Purpose

- The HCS will inform the Area Plan by:
 - Revealing the land development history of the planning area.
 - Providing recommended goals, policies and IPs that support preservation of historic resources while accommodating necessary growth and development.
 - Informing the Cultural Resources section of a plan's EIR.
- The HCS will provide the foundation for subsequent historic resources surveys.



HCS Process and Schedule

- 1. Hold a public meeting to introduce the project and request information.
- 2. Conduct a windshield survey, research, and interviews.
- 3. Draft HCS
- 4. Provide draft HCS to stakeholders for feedback: October 2024
- 5. Present draft HCS to the public for feedback: December 2024
- 6. Present draft HCS to the Landmarks Commission for feedback: April 2025
- 7. Finalize HCS: May 2025



Requested Information

- Information
 - Historic buildings, structures, sites or areas worthy of preservation.
 - Events or people important to the area's history.
 - Historical issues to be addressed by the Area Plan
- Stakeholder Participation
- Due August 2, 2024
