

## LIKE-FOR-LIKE REBUILD



"Like-for-like" replacement structures must be the same size, in the same location, and for the same land use as the legally established damaged or destroyed structure. The like-for-like replacement structure may be approved with modifications if they do not increase the floor area, size, height, or building footprint by more than 10%. ## **Step 1: Site Clearance and Application Submission**

## **Site Clearance**

- Phase 1: Household Hazardous Debris Removal The U.S. EPA has initiated the removal of hazardous materials. The EPA must provide clearance before moving to Phase 2.
- Phase 2: Fire Debris Removal Property owners can opt in for free cleanup by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers or opt out and pay a specialized, approved contractor to remove the remaining fire debris. Opt in/opt out deadline: March 31, 2025
