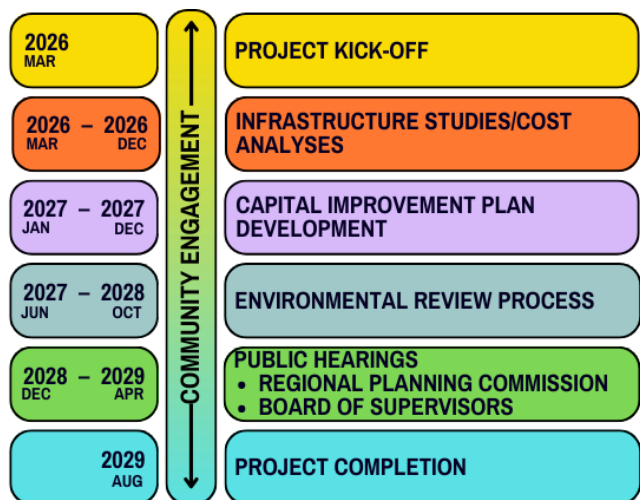


# EAST SAN GABRIEL VALLEY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

LA County is establishing a Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) for the unincorporated communities in the East San Gabriel Valley (ESGV) planning area.

## WHAT IS A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN (CIP)?

A CIP is a long-term strategic plan that guides how the County prioritizes, plans, and funds infrastructure projects over the next 5-10 years. The CIP will focus on maintaining, improving, and expanding essential public infrastructure, specifically related to **mobility/transportation, stormwater, sewer, drinking water, and energy**. It will prioritize projects and identify potential funding sources and estimated timelines for implementation.

The CIP will support the land use strategies in the recently adopted East San Gabriel Valley Area Plan.

CIPs are intended to improve infrastructure that enhances quality of life, can accommodate future growth, and build communities' climate resilience.
